I am the War Bride of Lawrence Boroff. He was in the Canadian Army, and went overseas on the Queen Elizabeth around November 1942. He fought in Italy, France, Belgium, Germany and in 1945 entered Holland with the liberating army and the Canadians liberated Holland. We were married on December 1, 1945. He left for Canada in April of 1946 from England and I followed in August of 1946 and landed in Canada August 13, 1946. I was born in Holland: my maiden name was Bouwmeester. I left my parents and two brothers behind.

It was tough at first, but I learned to love Canada and I still do. I have gone back and visited my family quite often but I am always glad to come home to Canada. Holland will always have a special place in my heart but here is my home, CANADA.
