I was a war Bride. I left
Liverpool, England on the
6th June, 1945 aboard the Samaria, and we took about nine days to
cross the Atlantic and the ship Scythia was almost always within sight
during the crossing, being back-ups for each other so we understood, in
case of stray U-boats still operating in the Atlantic. The newspaper
cutting was in the local paper given to us as we embarked on the train to
carry us to our first destinations in Canada.
