Journey: Came in convoy to Canada. All but two ships left us at Newfoundland. Raining at Pier 21 (I thought I was in England). Processing and train Trip to St. John, N.B. were fine.

I stayed with my husband's sister for three months because I couldn't get a place to live with a child and a dog. I lived in one room for nine months. My thoughts of Canada then were not great. After my husband re-joined the army things were much better. I belong to a war brides club in Vancouver. I left England on May 6th 1945 and it took 14 days to get to Canada.
