We had to be ready to leave
England at 24 hours

notice. We embarked on 5 April 1945 at Glasgow, after an all night train journey from London. Arrived at Halifax on 18 April 1945. The name of the ship was "Nea Hellas" and we were in a convoy. We had to sleep fully clothed all the way across and even on docking at Halifax in the evening we were told to remain dressed for the night.
